Meeting Minutes – June 10th, 2026 Regular Business Meeting

Our monthly Wednesday business meeting of the Town of Summit Volunteer Fire Department was called to order by Association President, Dale Rochon at 6:05 on June 10th, 2026, at the Town of Summit Town Hall.

Treasurer's report: Balance as of May 31st, 2026: Checking \$5,609.27 – Savings account \$36,229.35. The 3 CDs \$32,386.88. CDs interest rate for all 3 are 3.7% with renewal dates of 8/27 for CD #1 and 9/27 for CDs #2 and 3.

Secretaries report: May 2026 secretary report was present.

- Motion to approve secretaries report Steeve Fegraeus and 2nd Mike Edwards.

Chief's report:

- 2 mutual aid wildland fire, 1 mutual aid medical, 1 MVA, 2 gas smells, 1 smoke smell and 1 medical for the month of May.
- Motion to accept chief's report made by Steve Fegraeus and 2nd Mike Edwards.

Old business:

- Ticket raffle: Still have about 100 tickets left to sell. Need to push ticket sales. We have them at 5 local taverns. The Backyard and Drifters have posters hanging to advertise the raffle. Plan for future gun raffles to have posters at all 5 local taverns.
- Sign up for dates in July to draw raffle tickets being passed around at the meeting. The raffle will be nightly in July at 6:30 at the Amnicon Bar. Directions on how to draw tickets will be on the Calendar.
- Updates on grants: Several grants being worked on at this time. No new updates
- Lights on truck update: The tanker front grill lights not working. The light. Bar quit working on the tanker during the grass fire, but worked again at the vehicle roll over.
- Headlights and brush guard on BAB: Headlights have been changed and brush guard at Hammer paint shop.
- June 17th training: Waiting to do extrication training until July, as not enough people available to attend. Dale and Steve will be training members on the brush truck and BAB.
- DNR wants to hold a meeting for the Dedham Rd fire. Will be June 22nd in the evening. 7 people to attend.



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- Update on May 29th concert. Raised \$629 dollars. There will be another one this Saturday, June 13th. Looking for people to help raise donations.
- Pancake breakfast: \$300 donation from Lonny and Cathleen Lundberg
- Request for backpack EMR bags. To have 1 on BAB and 1 on the brush truck. Motion to approve using the money from the pancake breakfast to purchase the bags made by Sarah, Rae Ann 2nd the motion. All attendees at the meeting voted in favor, with no opposed. Kristy researching bag options and will send a message to the group on what she finds. All attendees agreed that 1 large bag and 1 small bag to be purchased.
- Raffle license numbers need to be reported out for our license. If the 50/50 tickets are used, members need to write down the starting and ending numbers of the tickets.
- Head of the Lakes Fair enduro races: Fire is signed up to do it. No EMS needed. July 24th and 25th. Brush truck and tanker to be used.

New business:

- New run reports for EMS have been picked up by Kristy. Old ones need to be used up first. They are in the file cabinet.
- Cascade system. Had electrician there today working on it and will finish it tomorrow.
- Need to look at how we want to build another holder for the SCBA bottles. We have a company that will donate steel to build brackets if needed.
- BAB electrical issue: Had several shorts, which Steve fixed. Also need a recharge kit for the AC. Will need a 100 ft cord with 20 amp plug to have for BAB. Steve to pick theses items up.
- Wire cutters needed for the brush truck for cutting fence.
- Request for 2 nozzles for the tuck for pump and roll. Can get the lexon nozzles that can be purchased through the DNR warehouse. Possibly be requested in the DNR grant. Tony looking into that.
- Request for backpack coolers for water. Waiting to purchase due to funding.
- June 15th Association meeting at Solon Springs Fire Hall at 1900.
- Raffle tickets need to be given to Kristy no later than June 29th. Kristy will have everything at Amnicon Bar on June 30th.
- 4th of July parade: Motion to use \$400 to purchase candy made by Candus and 2nd by Sarah. Dan Corbin will pick up the candy. Meet at Steve's driveway at 1030.
- Bonnie's bobber is at Kristy's house. Needs to be sand blasted and painted.
